<input type="checkbox"/>	Wash water from vehicle or equipment washing	Water from vehicle washing is a prohibited discharge to the storm drain system. Vehicles should be washed in a car wash or on lawn surfaces that can absorb water.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wash water from pressure washing or surface washing	A point source discharge of pollutants into waters of the United States w/out an NPDES permit is prohibited. Compliance efforts include vacuuming process wastewater or berming process water and allowing it to evaporate, and discharging water to an NPDES permitted sanitary sewer system.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Leakage from stored materials or waste	Use tight-sealing lids on fluid containers. Organize storage for easy access in case of a leak or spill. Use tarps, drip pans, and other spill collection devices; immediately manage any waste properly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Oil leakage from vehicle	Check for vehicle oil leaks and fix them promptly. Use ground cloths or drip pans beneath your vehicle if you have leaks or are doing engine work. Clean up spills and dispose of motor oil at local recycling facility.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Debris/trash accumulation evident on the ground or around a dumpster	Cover. Close. And Clean dumpster area. Fix leaks and use spill kit to clean immediately.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Discharging chlorinated pool water into street and or near storm drain	Drain pool water to pervious or vegetated landscape (lawn).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Grass clippings/yard waste on street/sidewalk and or near storm drain	Yard debris is a significant source of stormwater pollution. Leave the clippings on the lawn or compost them. Sweep or blow clippings off paved surfaces and back into the lawn.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Failure to dispose of animal/pet waste	Put pet waste in the trash or flush it down the toilet for sewage facility treatment.
