

WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2 OF 2017

WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE AMENDING WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE 5-2002 AMENDING THE KILLED IN SERVICE BENEFIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ACT 51

WHEREAS, Act 51 was signed into law by the Governor and became effective October 9, 2009 and provided for certain killed in service benefits funded by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, Act 51 repeals the provisions of Act 600 which authorized the killed in service benefit; and

WHEREAS, West Wyoming Borough Ordinance 5-2002, as amended, of the Borough of West Wyoming Police Pension Plan presently provides for a killed in service survivor benefit; and

WHEREAS, the existing Borough Police Pension Plan killed in service benefit will be replaced and superseded by killed in service benefits provided under Act 51;

Now therefore be it enacted and ordained by the Council for the Borough of West Wyoming as follows: West Wyoming Borough's Police Pension Plan Ordinance and specifically, Ordinance Number 5-2002 shall be, and hereby is, amended as follows:

Section 3 of Ordinance 5-2002 "Added Killed in Service Benefit" is hereby repealed in its entirety. In its place the following is adopted, to read in its entirety:


Act 51 Killed In Service Survivor Benefit. In the event of the death of a Police officer who is killed in service, survivor benefits shall consist of those benefits paid, outside of the Police Pension Plan of West Wyoming Borough, by the Commonwealth under Act 51 of 2009.


All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The provisions of this amended Ordinance are severable. If part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby. This Ordinance is Duly and enacted and ordained by West Wyoming Borough Council on 13 day of Feb, 2017 and signed by the Mayor on the 17 day Feb, 2017.
