WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE 13 WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE 106 – COMMONLY REFERENCED AS THE JUNKYARD ORDINANCE

West Wyoming Borough Council having received noise complaints regarding operations in the junkyard and therefore hereby sets consistent hours of operation for the junkyard and hereby amends the hours of operation for a Junkyard in West Wyoming Borough.

Now, therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of West Wyoming as follows:

Section I. Amendments to Hours of Operation.

Hours of operation for operating the junkyard are as follows:

- a) Monday through Friday 9:00 am through 5:00 pm;
- b) Saturday 9:00 am to 1:00 pm;
- c) Junkyard is closed on Sunday;
- d) No car crushing and no scrap metal loading is permitted on Saturday at any time;
- e) Car crushing and scrap metal loading permitted Monday through Friday from 9:00 am through 3:00pm only;
- f) No car crushing and no scrap metal loading permitted Monday through Friday 3:00 pm through 5:00pm;
- g) No operations after 5:00 pm nor before 9:00 am Monday through Friday;
- h) Junkyard closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Presidents' Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Section II.

The following sections in the current junkyard ordinance are repealed:

"Section 12. Use of Metal Crushers or Similar Devices." The entire section is repealed.

"Section 3. Posting of Junkyard Licenses; Operating procedures."

Number 2 is repealed.

Section III. Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby.

Section IV. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
