Resolution 2 of 2010: West Wyoming Adoption of Hazard Mitigation Plan

MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION ADOPTING BI-COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE COUNTIES OF LACKAWANNA AND LUZERNE, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as amended, requires that local and county governments develop and adopt hazard mitigation plans in order to receive certain Federal disaster assistance, and

WHEREAS, Lackawanna and Luzerne Counties, through their Planning Commissions and Emergency Management Agencies, obtained grant funding, selected a consultant team and prepared the required Plan to fulfill the Federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, a Hazard Mitigation Advisory Committee comprised of State and County staff, municipal officials, non-profit organizations and emergency management personnel from the Bi-County region, was formed to guide the development of the Plan by identifying the types of hazards, the areas of vulnerability and make recommendations on mitigation actions; and

WHEREAS, the local municipalities of both counties have had numerous opportunities to provide input and recommendations on the Plan; and

WHEREAS this effort of Lackawanna and Luzerne Counties has produced a Bi-County Hazard Mitigation Plan that has been reviewed and approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Elected Officials of West Wyoming Borough that the Bi-County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby approved and adopted.
