

ORDINANCE

REQUIRING BUILDING PERMITS IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING AND PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of West Wyoming, and it is ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION I. That from and after the passage of this ordinance no person, firm or corporation shall be permitted to construct any building in the Borough of West Wyoming without first obtaining from the Burgess a building permit, the cost whereof shall be \$1.00 for each \$1,000.00 or portion thereof, of construction cost.

SECTION II. Any person violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Burgess, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for said offense and in default of the payment thereof shall be sentenced to imprisonment either in the Borough Lockup or County Jail for a period of one day for each dollar of fine in default.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Borough of West Wyoming held on the 10th day of February, 1961.
