

PARKING ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of West Wyoming, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I:

PARKING: GENERAL REGULATIONS

At any time it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places:

- A. Within twenty (20) feet of any intersection.
- B. At any place where the standing of a vehicle will reduce the usable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than eighteen (18) feet.
- C. At any curb within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant.
- D. Parking vehicles within thirty (30) feet of an approach to a stop sign.
- E. On any sidewalk or portion of sidewalk.
- F. Designated times during Street Sweeping.
- G. Blocking any lane of traffic or driveway.
- H. All vehicles not parked parallel to the curb and within twelve (12) inches therefrom, unless marked by diagonal lines or signs indicating diagonal parking.
- I. Parking on private property.
- J. Parking or stopping with left side to curb.
- K. Stopping vehicle on crosswalk.
- L. Parking in a prohibited zone.
- M. Double parking.
- N. Parking in a handicapped zone without authorization.

SECTION II:

VEHICLES WITH INADEQUATE LIGHTS

It shall be unlawful to park on any street any vehicle not equipped with adequate light conforming to the requirements of the state traffic law.

SECTION III:

VEHICLES WITH ILLEGAL TIRES

It shall be unlawful to park on any street any motor vehicle which is not equipped with tires conforming to the requirements of the state traffic law.

SECTION IV:

PARKING LIMITED

No person shall park a vehicle on any street for a period of time longer than twenty-four (24) hours.

SECTION V:

UNLICENSED OR UNINSPECTED VEHICLES

It shall be unlawful to park on any street, any vehicle not licensed and inspected conforming to the requirements of the state traffic law.

SECTION VI:

VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

All persons, businesses, partnerships or corporations violating the provisions of this Article shall be subject to penalties of a fine of fifteen (\$15.00) dollars for each offense, and each daily occurrence of the same offense shall be considered a new offense and finable as such.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and same are hereby repealed.
