

6 WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WEST WYOMING BOROUGH FOR PROTECTING PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PRESCRIBING FOR VIOLATION.

The West Wyoming Borough Council hereby ordains:

§1. Definition and Interpretation. As used in this ordinance, the term PERSON shall include any individual, corporation, partnership, association, firm, or other legal entity. The singular shall include the plural; the plural shall include the singular; and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

§2. Tampering with Public Property on Streets, Alleys or Public Ground Prohibited. No person shall destroy, injure, tamper with or deface any public property of the West Wyoming Borough, or any grass, walk, lamp, ornamental work, building or street light on or in any of the streets, alleys, sidewalks, or public grounds in the West Wyoming Borough.

§3. Tampering with Stakes, Posts and Monuments Prohibited. No person shall in any manner interfere or meddle with, or pull, drive, change, alter, or destroy any stake, post, monument, or other marking, made, placed or set, or hereafter made, placed or set, or caused to be done by the authorities of the West Wyoming Borough, to evidence the location, elevation, line, grade, corner, or angle or any public street, alley, sidewalk, curb, gutter, drain, or other public work, or thing.

§4. Tampering with Warning Lamps, Signs or Barricades Prohibited. No person shall destroy, remove, deface, obliterate or cover up any lamp, sign or barricade erected as a warning of danger by the authorities of the West Wyoming Borough or by any person doing work by permission of the authorities of the West Wyoming Borough on any streets, alleys, sidewalks, or bridges in the West Wyoming Borough or on any public grounds of the West Wyoming Borough, within or without the West Wyoming Borough.

§5. Removal of Material from Streets, Alleys, or Public Grounds Prohibited. No person shall take any earth, stone, or other material from any street, alley, or public grounds in the West Wyoming Borough.

§6. Deposit of Harmful Substances on Streets, Alleys Sidewalks or Public Grounds Prohibited. No person shall pour, throw or deposit any harmful or destructive substance or matter on any street, alley, sidewalk or public grounds in the West Wyoming Borough.

§7. Exceptions. This ordinance shall not apply to normal activities in connection with construction, maintenance and repair of streets, alleys, sidewalks, and public grounds and the structures and fixtures located thereon or therein, or to incidental results of work done thereon or therein upon permit from or by authority of the West Wyoming Borough.


§8. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00), and/or to imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days. Every day that a violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.

§9. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

§10. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the West Wyoming Borough Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

§11. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on June 5, 1985.


