RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING REQUESTING PENNDOT TO INSTALL TIMING CHANGES ON TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF SHOEMAKER AVENUE (S.R.1010 )AND EIGHTH STREET (S.R.1021)
