21 WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE 105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING RESTRICTING THE DRIVING OF VEHICLES OVER CURBS AND SIDEWALKS; PLACING RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGES AND REPAIR THEREOF, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The West Wyoming Borough Council hereby ordains:

- §1. Procedure for Driving on Curbs or Sidewalks. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, to drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on, over and across any curb or sidewalk before first obtaining permission of the abutting property owner, and the placing of a proper platform, covering or other device for the protection of the sidewalk and curb.
- §2. Report Required of Damage to Curbs or Sidewalks. Any depression, break or damage caused to any curb or sidewalk by any vehicle, or by any other agency shall be reported to the Borough of West Wyoming within twenty-four (24) hours after the damage has occured, and emergency repairs must be made by the property owner, tenant or agent within forty-eight (48) hours after such report.
- §3. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), and/or to undergo imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days. Each day that a violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.
- §4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- §5. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the West Wyoming Borough Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
- §6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on June 5,
