

WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NUMBER 3

AMENDMENT TO WEST WYOMING POLICE PENSION FUND ORDINANCE  
REGARDING PROVISION OF SERVICE-RELATED DISABILITY BENEFIT  
MANDATED BY ACT 30

Whereas the Borough of West Wyoming is desirous of amending its Police Pension Fund Ordinance to comply with the provisions of Act 30;

Now, therefore be it enacted and Ordained by the Borough Council of West Wyoming as follows:

Section I:

Amendment to Add to the Police Pension ordinance the provision for a benefit of no less than 50 % of the Police member's salary at the time a disability is incurred, reduced by the amount of Social Security benefits received for the same injury.

If injured and deemed disabled from performing as a police member and eligible for the police pension fund, the police member shall collect a maximum of 51% of the member's salary at the time the disability was incurred, reduced by the amount of Social Security disability benefits received for the same injury.

Section II:

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby.

Section III: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section IV:

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to modify any ordinance reducing or eliminating the requirement of police contributions to the Pension Fund.


