Resolution No. 2 of 2017

Borough of West Wyoming

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of West Wyoming, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 322 of the disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of West Wyoming acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

**WHEREAS**, the Luzerne County Hazard Mitigation Plan 5-Year Update has been developed by the Luzerne County Planning Commission in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of West Wyoming Borough, and

**WHEREAS**, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Luzerne County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan 5-Year Update, and

**WHEREAS**, the Luzerne County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan 5-Year Update recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body for the Borough of West Wyoming:

The Luzerne County 2014 Update of the Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation plan of West Wyoming Borough, and

The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Luzerne County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan and hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
